
Kenya Conservation Safari.

5 Days

This 5-day Kenya Conservation Safari offers a sense of pride as you walk through Naretoi to the dam at the community-led Enonikishu Conservancy where you may spot incredible birdlife as well as learn about the essential oils harvested for DoTERRA on the neighboring farm or visit the “Wild Shamba.” Pay a visit to the Mara Training Centre and the nearby town. At the indigenous tree nursery, you’ll find a diverse range of trees and shrubs that are all native to East Africa.

Highlights

1. Experience a sense of place as you walk through Naretoi to the dam.
2. Take a visit to the local village and pop in to the Mara Training Centre



Day 1: Nairobi.

ARRIVAL

On arrival at the airport you will be met and briefed by our representative who'll then transfer you to your hotel where you are booked on bed and breakfast check in and overnight stay.

FLY TO BORANA (APPX 1 HR)

Depart early in the morning for schedule flight to Ngerende. Arrive in time for lunch, and then go on a game drive in the afternoon.

Day 3: Enonkishu.

FULL DAY LEMEK CONSERVANCY

Early morning wake-up call and depart for your game drive to watch the sunrise over the plains of the Lemek conservancy, with a packed breakfast. You'll have the opportunity to visit the Mara Elephant Project headquarters and learn about the conservation work being done to safeguard the Mara's elephants before returning to House in the Wild for lunch by the pool.

Day 4: Enonkishu.

FULL DAY ENONKISHU

Start your day with a cup of coffee and a stroll along the Naretoi roads in search of tracks and birds, followed by breakfast by the river. If you're looking for a more strenuous exercise, the Kileleoni Hill Climb with the KWS armed ranger is an option. Back to House in the Wild, have lunch before exploring the grounds, swimming, playing ping-pong or croquet, or catfish fishing in the river. Afternoon tour to the cattle bomas, followed by a trip to the local Manyatta (Maasai Village) and a bush meal at the Memusi waterhole in Enonkishu.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Upon Your confirmation of the booking, 50% of the total cost of services is required at the time of booking to confirm all the rooms and services.

Last and final payment of 50% of the total cost of services will be payable (45) days prior to service commencement date.

If, after our confirmation invoice has been issued, you wish to change your travel arrangements in any way, for example, your chosen arrival/departure date or an increase or reduction in number of rooms or services required, we will do our utmost to make these changes but it may not always be possible.

In the event you, or any member of your party, wishes to cancel your travel arrangements at any time. WRITTEN notification from the person who made the booking or your travel agent must be received at our offices. The following scale of cancellation will be payable depending on when the notification of cancellation is received:

- 90-60 days prior 20% of the holiday cost
- 59-30 days prior 50% of the holiday cost
- 29 days or less 100% of the holiday cost

It is very unlikely that we will have to make any changes to your travel arrangements. However, we do plan the arrangements many months in advance and occasionally, therefore, it may be necessary to make changes and we reserve the right to do so at any time. Most of these changes will be minor and we will advise you or your travel agent of them if practicable and time permitting.

Please note that carriers, timings and routings given in the brochure are for guidance only and may be subject to change. Such changes are deemed to be minor changes. Other examples of minor changes include changes to domestic aircraft type or change of accommodation to another of the same standard.
