This 9-day Kenya Luxury Safari covers three of Kenya's top wildlife sites. You'll stay in a private rhino reserve in the Laikipia region and visit the rock that allegedly inspired the filmmakers to create *Pride Rock* — you can even sit on it and have a sundowner drink! Then it's on to Westgate Conservancy, where you'll go on game drives with Samburu warriors and track lions before closing in style at a tented camp in the Masai Mara. You'll get a classic savannah safari experience here, with lion pride and hyena clans, as well as the spectacle of tens of thousands of migrating wildebeest if it's migration season..

On arrival at the airport you will be met and briefed by our representative who'll then transfer you to your hotel where you are booked on bed and breakfast check in and overnight stay.



FLY TO BORANA (APPX 1 HR)

Depart early in the morning for schedule flight to Lewa Dons. Arrive in time for lunch, and then go on a game drive in the afternoon.

Day 3: Borana.

FULL DAY BORANA

The opportunities at Borana Lodge are endless.

Spend the morning on horseback exploring the valleys and undulating hills of Borana Conservancy, head out for a guided bush walk to appreciate the smaller creatures and flora, opt for a game drive in search of big cats or simply relax by the pool and make the most of the in-house masseuse. The day is yours to be as active as you please.

Day 4: Borana.

FULL DAY BORANA

Spend the morning with parts of Borana Conservancy's anti-poaching team tracking black rhino on foot. This is vital to Borana's conservation efforts as all rhinos are to be accounted for on a daily basis. By tracking and identifying individual rhino with the conservancy's scouts you are having a direct impact on conservation. This is an early morning activity, returning to Borana Lodge for breakfast.

Day 5-6: Westgate.

FLY TO WESTGATE CONSERVANCY (APPX 1 HR)

A flight takes you from Laikipia to the Samburu Airstrip and a luxurious lodge that looks out over rolling plains towards Mount Kenya. A drier, harsher landscape than Laikipia, Samburu is nevertheless excellent for wildlife and offers a unique mix of classic savannah animals and those of the northern deserts such as unique long-necked gerenuk antelopes. You enjoy game drives before spending time with local conservationists and learning how to track creatures like lions and elephants. A family highlight is the camel safari that takes you for sundowner drinks – and quad biking is available as an optional extra. Your accommodation is the wonderful Sasaab Camp, an especially well-appointed camp with private plunge pools in each suite and comforts such as Wi-Fi, a health and beauty spa, gym, a babysitting service and free laundry. There's also the chance to spend a night in the wilderness: ask us about the Sasaab fly-camping experience and sleeping out under the stars.

FLY TO MASAI MARA (APPX 2 HRS)

Day 8: Departure:

Before breakfast, you will go on an early morning game drive. This pre-breakfast game drive provides excellent opportunities to see Big Cats hunting or sharing a kill. At this hour, some elusive animals, such as the leopard, may be seen. You return to the lodge for breakfast before flying to Nairobi where on arrival you will transfer to the international airport for your onwards travel arrangements.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Upon Your confirmation of the booking, 50% of the total cost of services is required at the time of booking to confirm all the rooms and services.

Last and final payment of 50% of the total cost of services will be payable (45) days prior to service commencement date.

If, after our confirmation invoice has been issued, you wish to change your travel arrangements in any way, for example, your chosen arrival/departure date or an increase or reduction in number of rooms or services required, we will do our utmost to make these changes but it may not always be possible.

In the event you, or any member of your party, wishes to cancel your travel arrangements at any time. WRITTEN notification from the person who made the booking or your travel agent must be received at our offices. The following scale of cancellation will be payable depending on when the notification of cancellation is received:

- 90-60 days prior 20% of the holiday cost
- 59-30 days prior 50% of the holiday cost
- 29 days or less 100% of the holiday cost

It is very unlikely that we will have to make any changes to your travel arrangements. However, we do plan the arrangements many months in advance and occasionally, therefore, it may be necessary to make changes and we reserve the right to do so at any time. Most of these changes will be minor and we will advise you or your travel agent of them if practicable and time permitting.

Please note that carriers, timings and routings given in the brochure are for guidance only and may be subject to change. Such changes are deemed to be minor changes. Other examples of minor changes include changes to domestic aircraft type or change of accommodation to another of the same standard.
